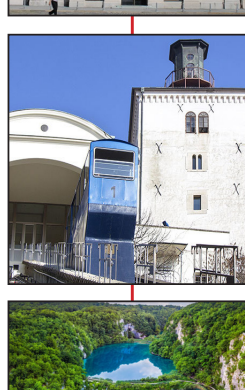
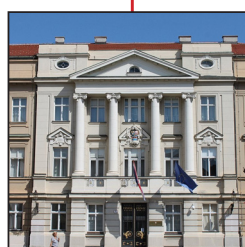
DAY 1

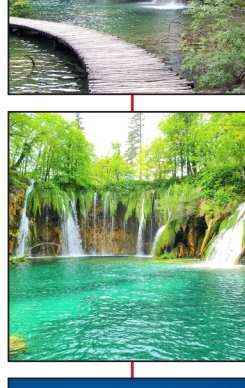

**Free time for Lunch. Departure to the Plitvice Lakes. Arrival at 16 Lakes Hotel (4\*), check-in, and dinner.**

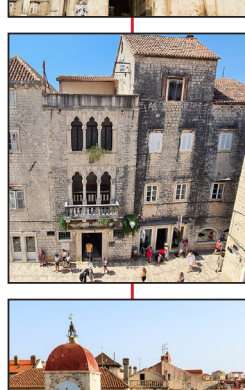

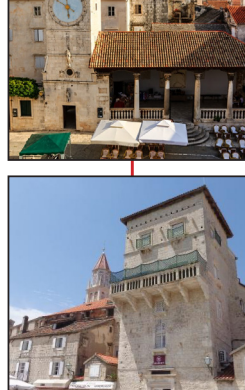

This National Park is a Croatian gem boasting stunning cascading waterfalls, crystal-clear lakes, lush greenery, and diverse wildlife.



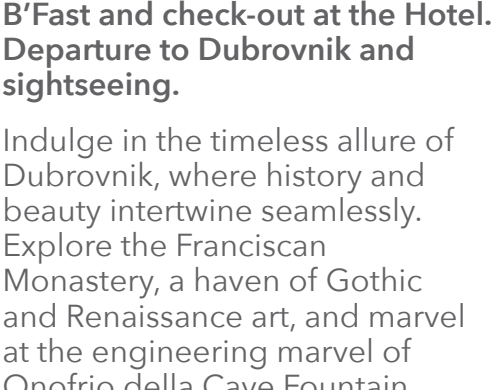
**Departure to Trogir. Free time for lunch. Sightseeing of Trogir with licensed local guide.**



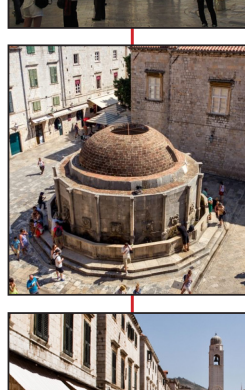

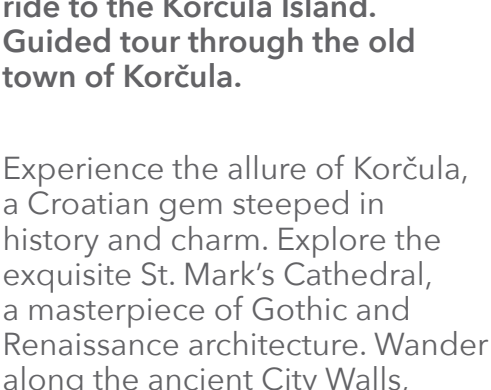
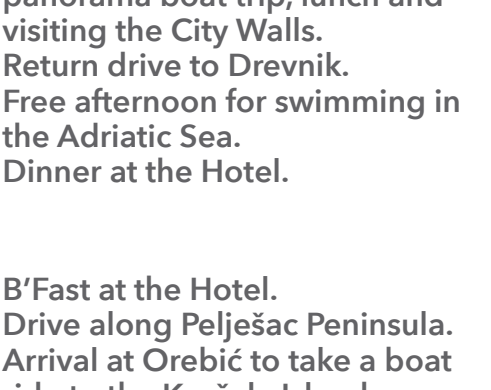


**B'Fast and check-out at the Hotel. Departure to Dubrovnik and sightseeing.**

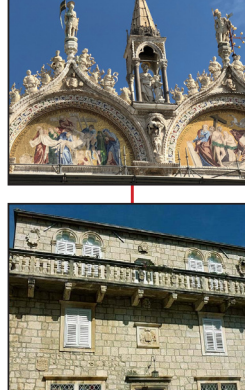

DAY 4

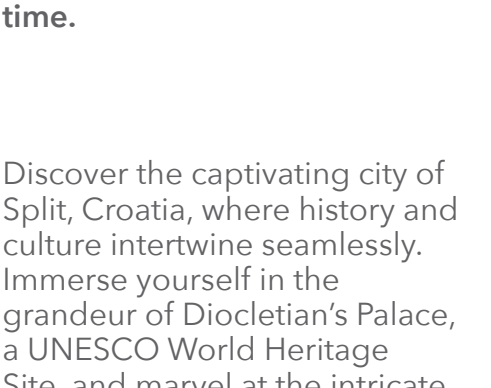

DAY 5

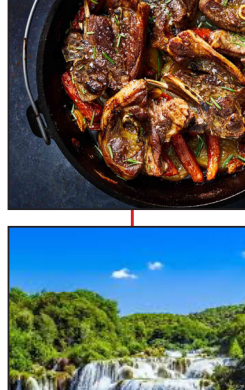


**B'Fast and check-out at the Hotel. Departure to Split for sightseeing with licensed tour guide and free time.**

DAY 6

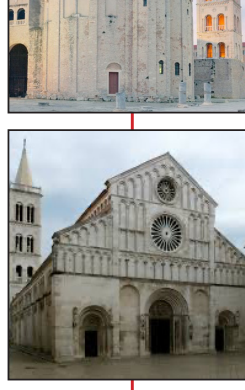


**B'Fast at the Hotel. Departure to Nin for sightseeing with a licensed tour guide. Free time.**

**Drive to Zadar for sightseeing with a licensed tour guide. Free time for lunch.**



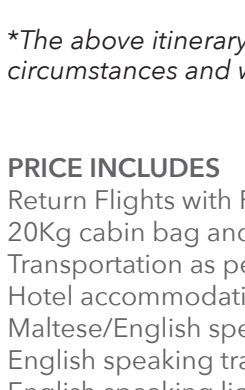
