DAY 2




Uplistsikhe Ancient City

Bagrati Cathedral

The cathedral is a UNESCOlisted masterpiece. Dating back to the 11th century, its stunning architecture and historical significance make it a symbol of Georgian heritage.



Gelati Monastery

The monastery epitomizes medieval ecclesiastical grandeur. Founded by King David IV, it houses stunning frescoes, mosaics, and a significant burial site, embodying Georgian Christianity.



Borjomi - hot springs park

Rabati Castle

Khertvisi Castle

The castle, Georgia's oldest fortress, is a formidable symbol of medieval military architecture. Perched on a rocky outcrop, it guards history and commands scenic views of the surrounding landscape.



Vardzia

A complex cave monastery with its rock-hewn architecture and ancient frescoes. Carved into cliffs, it stands as a testament to medieval Christian faith and architectural ingenuity.



Pass through the Georgia - Armenia Gyumri border gate. Excursion to Gyumri city. Check-in at Hotel in Gyumri.



Gyumri

The city is the second largest in Armenia, and boasts rich cultural heritage, charming cobblestone streets, and distinctive architecture. Despite historical challenges, Gyumri thrives with resilience, warmth, and a vibrant community spirit.



Breakfast at the Hotel. Departure to Saghmosavank Monastery. Coffee break at Aparan.



Saghmosavank Monastery

The monastery was built in the 13th century. From here you will admire one of the most breathtaking views of the Kasakh gorge.

Yerevan

Yerevan is also known as the Pink Capital because all the buildings of the city are made of Armenian pink stone called tuff.

Opera and Ballet Theatre

The theatre is an architectural gem built by the capital's architect Alexander Tamanyan, and hosts world-class performances. Its grandeur and cultural significance make it a captivating venue.



Matenadaran

Yerevan's ancient manuscript repository, houses an invaluable collection of illuminated manuscripts and ancient texts, preserving Armenia's literary and cultural heritage through the ages.



Garni Pagan Temple

The temple was built in the 1st century AD. It is the only temple remaining from the Pagan period in Armenia. It was dedicated to Mihr, the Sun God, and was a gift to the queen. It was destroyed by an earthquake in 1679. In 1975 the Temple was restored.



Departure to Geghard.

A cliff-surrounded medieval monastery partially carved into the adjacent mountain. It is on the UNESCO World Heritage List. While the main chapel was built in 1215, the monastery complex was founded in the 4th century by Gregory the Illuminator on the site of a holy spring inside a cave. Return to the Hotel in Yerevan.



DAY 6

Departure to Lake Sevan towards the Armenia-Georgia border gate. Check-in at the Hotel in Tbilisi.



Lake Sevan





The booking deposit is usually in the region of €250 per person. This deposit will be considered a payment on account of your holiday and by paying it you are committing yourself to pay the full amount payable of the holiday. The balance is due 6 weeks prior to the date of departure or immediately. The deposit is either paid by cash or cheque and not refundable.

It is compulsory, when travelling with YTC, to have a holiday insurance covering the whole period of your holiday, not only for your protection

and your baggage, but also in case of cancellations.

YTC can offer you an insurance, which will be cheaper since we are booking as a group not individuals. Alternatively you can arrange a

booking as a group not individuals. Alternatively you can arrange a policy yourself giving comparable or better cover under all sections. Prior to every tour you will be given a date and time for the informative meeting which is compulsory for you and all the adult members in your group.

Seat allocations are at the sole discretion of the airline, except for singular reasons.

You need to be in possession of a valid passport and any appropriate VISA

Make sure to check passport and VISA requirements well in advance especially if you are travelling to a country outside Europe and non-Schengen area, and if you are a non-Maltese passport holder.

Any surcharge on extra weight on luggage is to be borne by you with the airline. Luggage has to be seen to, carried and packed by the owner at all times.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you carry a European Health Insurance card (E111) for travel within the EU countries.

Keep the leader's mobile number at hand and also the name of the hotel you are staying at, in case you get lost.

If you are not going to attend to any of the excursions please inform YTC preferably before your holiday starts; whilst you are still in Malta. Children are solely the responsibility of the parents or guardians throughout the holiday.

YTC condemns any disruptive, dangerous or annoying behaviour by you or your children to the people around you or damages to any property. YTC will not pay any refund of any cost incurred by this behaviour.

Departure times are advised beforehand and should you be late, the leader reserves the right to depart at the appointed time, and does not accept any responsibility for any missed transport by the client which has to be replaced at the client's expense.

Rooms are distributed according to the list we provide to the accommodation providers. Any lost keys have to be paid for.

Meals are a three course set menu with moderate portions. Please let us know beforehand if you have any food intolerance or if you are vegetarian or vegan. Drinks including water and wine are not always included with the meal.

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Same goes if you fall ill, the leader will ask the hotel reception for a doctor which needs to be paid by you and the receipt claimed with your insurance on your arrival to Malta.

If any part of your holiday is lost due to natural disasters, bad weather, industrial actions, war, government restrictions or any matter of force majeure, YTC cannot be held liable to pay compensation or pay for damages incurred.

If you have a problem or cause for complaint, bring it to the attention of the tour leader or hotel reception whilst abroad not after your arrival to Malta.
