DAY 1



Meeting at Malta International Airport, check-in and departure with Tunisia Express. Arrival at Carthage Airport, Tunis Gammarth. Transfer to Hotel in Tunis, check-in, and rest.



Check-in at the Hotel and rest. Afternoon excursion to the Bardo Museum and Medina, Tunis Zitouna Mosque. Return to the Hotel for Dinner.



## **Bardo Museum**

This museum houses an extensive collection of ancient artifacts and artworks, spanning from prehistoric times to the Islamic period.



Medina, Tunis Zitouna Mosque Medina is a UNESCO World Heritage site, featuring the historic Zitouna Mosque. Established in the 8th century, it's a significant Islamic and architectural landmark.





B'Fast at the Hotel. Excursion to Sidi Bou Said. Visit the Nejma Ezahna Palace. After lunch at a local restaurant travel to the Catharge Ruins and return to the Hotel for Dinner.



## Sidi Bou Said

A charming coastal town near Tunis, renowned for its blue and white architecture, picturesque streets, and stunning views of the Mediterranean Sea.



## Neima Ezahna Palace

This palace is a luxurious hotel showcasing traditional Moorish architecture. With opulent interiors, lush gardens, and modern amenities, it offers a regal and serene retreat.



# Carthage Ruins

These ruins hold immense historical significance as the ancient capital of the Carthaginian Empire. They witness pivotal events, including the Punic Wars, shaping Mediterranean history.





B'Fast at the Hotel and check-out. Travel to Tozeur via Kairiuran to visit Okba Ibn Nefaa, Sidi Sahbi Mausoleum.

Lunch at a local restaurant and travel to the Hotel in Tozeur, check-in and dinner.



## Kairouan

This mosque was founded in 670 CE, renowned as the Great Mosque of Kairouan, a masterpiece of Islamic architecture, bearing cultural and religious significance as a centre of learning.



## Okba Ibn Nefaa

Okba Ibn Nefaa was an Arab military commander who played a crucial role in the Islamic conquests. He founded Kairouan and contributed significantly to early Muslim expansion.



## Sidi Sahbi Mausoleum

The burial place of Sidi Sahbi, a companion of Prophet Muhammad. A revered pilgrimage site, it reflects Islamic architectural and cultural heritage.





B'Fast at the Hotel, check-out and head off to the Sahara Desert to see the Chebika Oasis, Mides and the Tamerza waterfall. After lunch in a Palmeraie, visit the Star Wars Site. Return to the Hotel for dinner.



## Chebika Oasis

This oasis is in south western Tunisia, it is a captivating desert retreat with palm trees and natural springs, offering a picturesque and serene escape.



## Mides

A Tunisian village, that boasts stunning landscapes with canyons and mountains. Known for its unique setting, it has attracted filmmakers and travellers seeking its picturesque beauty.



# Tamerza waterfall

This waterfall Waterfall is a breathtaking natural wonder surrounded by arid landscapes, offering a refreshing and scenic oasis in the desert.



# Star Wars Site

The site features the iconic troglodyte dwellings used as the backdrop for Luke Skywalker's home on Tatooine, enhancing its cultural allure.

Prior to every tour you will be given a date and time for the informative meeting which is compulsory for you and all the adult members in

Seat allocations are at the sole discretion of the airline, except for singular reasons.

You need to be in possession of a valid passport and any appropriate

Make sure to check passport and VISA requirements well in advance especially if you are travelling to a country outside Europe and non-Schengen area, and if you are a non-Maltese passport holder.

Any surcharge on extra weight on luggage is to be borne by you with the airline. Luggage has to be seen to, carried and packed by the owner at all times.
